


Greetings Matriarchs,

## JOAN Patterson February 1, 1931-June 21, 2014 Arizona Rebekah Assembly President 1992-1993




Joan Carol "Joanie" Patterson, 83, of Grants Pass died June 21st at Three Rivers Medical Center after a long battle with lung disease. A graveside service was held at Eagle Point National Cemetery. Joan was born February 1, 1931, in Chicago to Henry and Rose Linder. After graduating from Lakeview High School in Chicago in 1948, she worked as a keypunch operator at two major companies. At the second company, Caterpillar Corp. in Joliet, Ill., she became skilled in wiring panels for the IBM punched card machines. On January 29, 1954, she married George Patterson, who survives. In May 1954 they moved to Tucson, Arizona, for her husband's work and they raised their family there. When two of her sons were in middle school and one in high school, she went to work as a clerk-secretary for a lawyer. During that time, she began taking legal classes at the University of Arizona. Soon thereafter, she was hired by the Pima County Court Administration Office in Tucson. Two years later, she was hired as a legal secretary for two lawyers in a legal firm. She served as Arizona Rebekah Assembly President 1992-1993. In 1997 after her husband's retirement they settled in Grants Pass. Joan was a member of Etna Rebekah Lodge No. 49 in Grants Pass.

# **UNEP** Tour a Success



The 23 Oregon delegates returned from the tour on July 10, 2014 and they had a very successful time. For 13 days they toured the East Coast and saw a lot of great things. They also made many friends as they


went. They traveled with a bus of about 50 delegates from Denmark, Iowa, Finland, Tennessee, West Virginia, Washington and Oregon. While they were in New York City, there were a total of 150 delegates there. In New York City, every delegate is required to give a speech and then the top 6 speakers give their speeches in front of everyone and the top two speakers are given scholarships. Amber Harvey from Clackamas High School took first place and a \$1,000 scholarship. Shawn Lee (also from Clackamas!) placed second and won a \$500 scholarship. Renee Kuzmenko (also from Clackamas!) and Rachel Bennion from Medford were also in the final six. Four of this year's six speech finalists were from Oregon! Oregon has now won 5 of the 6 scholarships given in the last 3 years.

While the speeches and the scholarships are impressive, what interests me more is how every delegate got along. The two words I have heard repeated many times are "Amazing!" and "Awesome!" The kids have told me that they had a wonderful trip and enjoyed seeing parts of America they may never see again. They visited historical sites and enjoyed the beauty that is America. They have told me of their friendships that they have had and they have told me of the heartache they felt as they had to say goodbye to their new best friends when it was time to come home.

I hope all of them contact the lodges who sent them and thank you. They and their families have thanked me many times. However, I do know that things get in the way and their lives get busy. Sometimes they are invited to speak at a lodge, but getting out in the evening is difficult for them. Sometimes we forget they are only 16 and 17 and many don't drive yet. I hope they thank you directly, but if they don't... please understand that they do very much appreciate the gift you have given them. Also... I want to thank all of the lodges and individuals who have supported the UNEP this year.
