



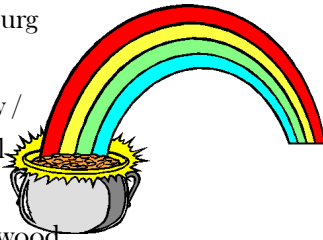

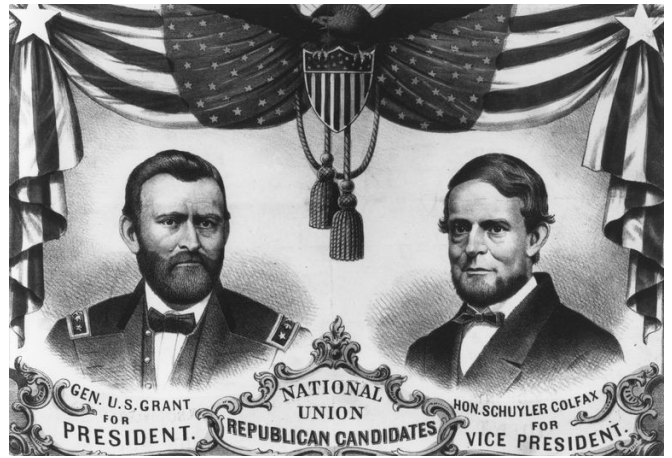

Schuyler Colfax: The Order Honors Him on His Birthday, March 23rd



Schuyler Colfax Jr., one of America's most colorful statesmen was born on March 23, 1823. He was an American journalist, businessman, and politician from Indiana. He served as a United States

Representative, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the 17th Vice President of the United States. This man, Schuyler Colfax, was an ardent Odd Fellow. He fought for and obtained the world's first auxiliary for women in any Fraternal Order. It was the Rebekah degree, and Colfax himself wrote the impressive ritual, which still stands today as a monumental example of its type. The Order honors him on his birthday.

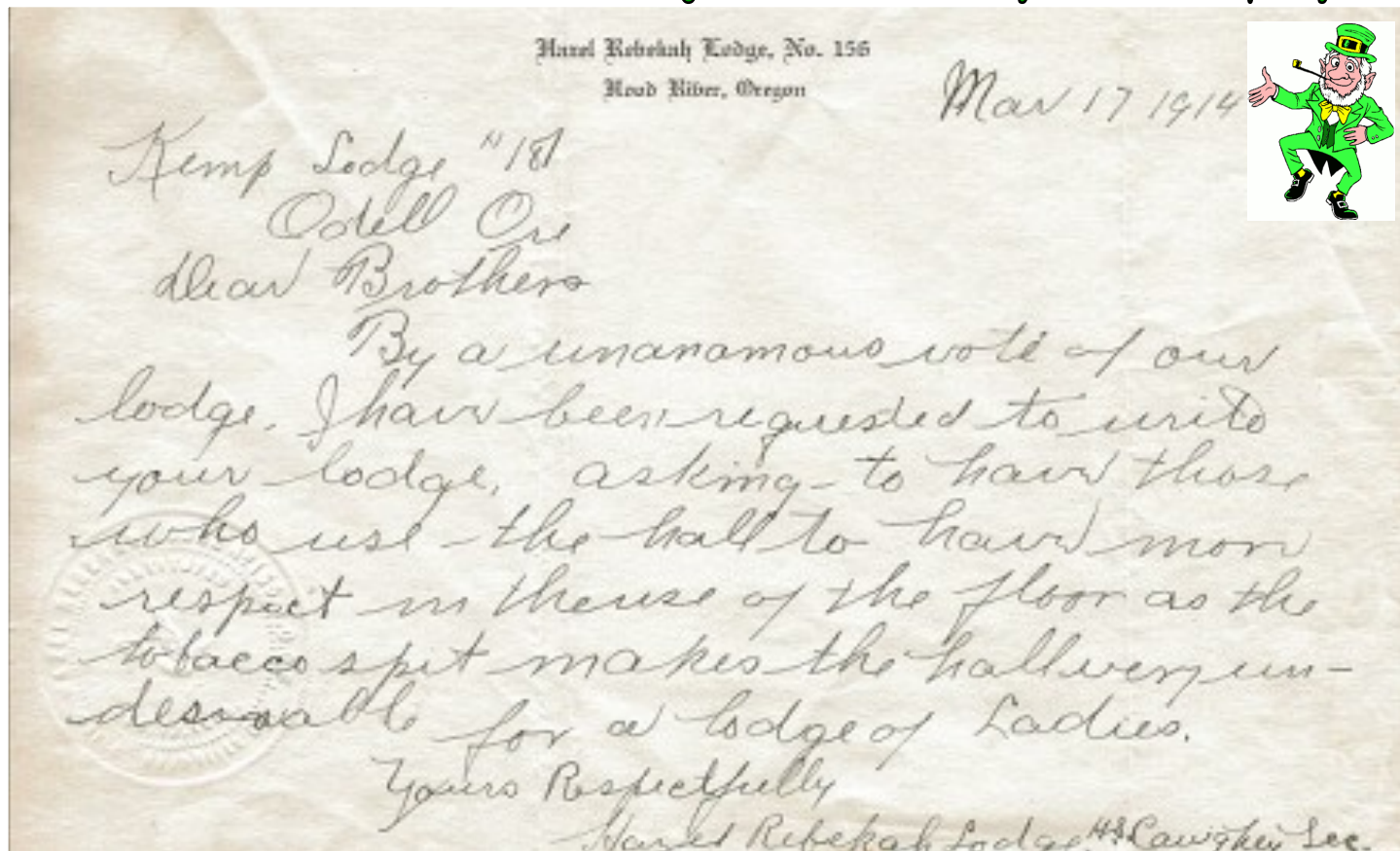
