Thank you to the editors for their hard work.


All in all this has been a great experience with lasting memories that I wouldn't trade for anything.

kindness and hospitality I received from the Oregon Encampments. I got to know many Patriarchs as I visited each Encampment three or four times either in person or Zoom meetings.




And so, with thanks to everyone, I am looking forward to assuming the office of PAST GRAND PATRI-ARCH.
